## A Unique Program

CMS4S registrants must understand the minimum requirements for the US EPA National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) stormwater permit requirements, as it relates to overall coordination and implementation of the MS4 operations.

Registrants must document proficiencies in each of the NPDES Minimum Control Measures: Public Education and Outreach; Public Participation and Involvement; Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination; Construction Site Runoff Control; Post-Construction Runoff Control; Pollution Prevention and Good Housekeeping Practices as well as overall Program Management & Documentation, Program Funding, and Program Audits & Evaluation.



## Certified Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Specialist Certification Program

■ The Certified Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Specialist™ Certification Program (CMS4S™) was created by EnviroCert International, Inc. in conjunction with an international oversight committee of MS4 operators and stormwater professionals.

## Who Can Apply?

The program is available to all qualified MS4 program staff, operators, coordinators, and others who wish to demonstrate their proficiencies.

## Candidate Qualifications

Candidates must have at least 5 years of directly related experience and possess a high school diploma (or equivalent) along with work references.

## Additional Provisions

Registrants must subscribe to a Code of Conduct and Ethics, pay an annual renewal fee and provide proof of continuing education credits. Individuals interested in certification should check with the appropriate regulatory authorities to determine acceptance of this certification. **Note that certification is not a substitute for any required professional license.**

## A New Industry Standard

CMS4Ss are being recognized throughout the United States as individuals who have demonstrated the minimum proficiencies needed to effectively manage MS4 programs. Specific state requirements may be added to the certification process.

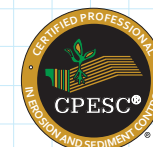
